

District 13 – Metro Atlanta Boundary Descriptions

Zone A: Portions of Sandy Springs in Fulton County lying north of Interstate 285 (I-285) and south of the Chattahoochee River. (Includes 8111 Club)

Zone B: Portions of Sandy Springs and Atlanta in central Fulton County (Includes Triangle Club)

Northern Boundary: Interstate 285 (I-285)

Western Boundary: Interstate 75 (I-75) beginning at Interstate 285 (I-285) and running southeast to its intersection (Brookwood interchange) with Interstate 85 (I-85) in midtown Atlanta)

Eastern Boundary: Fulton county boundary with DeKalb County

Southern Boundary: Interstate 85 (I-85) beginning at DeKalb county boundary and running southwest to its intersection (Brookwood interchange) with Interstate 75 (I-75) in midtown Atlanta)

Zone C: Merged with District 13G in 2006; Zone C no longer exists.

Zone D: DeKalb County lying east and southeast of Interstate 285 (I-285) and south of Interstate 85 (I-85) (Clarkston, Stone Mountain, Lithonia)

Zone E: Portions of Atlanta in central Fulton County (Includes Galano Club)

Northern Boundary: (1) Interstate 75 (I-75) beginning at Chattahoochee River (Fulton/Cobb County boundary) and running southeast to its intersection (Brookwood interchange) with Interstate 85 (I-85) in midtown Atlanta and (2) Interstate 85 (I-85) beginning at the Fulton/DeKalb County boundary and running southwest to its intersection (Brookwood interchange) with Interstate 75 (I-75) in midtown Atlanta

Western Boundary: Chattahoochee River (Fulton/Cobb County boundary)

Eastern Boundary: Fulton county boundary with DeKalb County

Southern Boundary: Interstate 20 (I-20)

Zone F: All of Clayton County and a portion of southern Fulton County (College Park, East Point, Hapeville, Palmetto, Fairburn, Riverdale, Jonesboro, and the portions of Atlanta) (Includes Tara Club and Clayton House)

Northern Boundary: Interstate 20 (I-20)

Western Boundary: Fulton County boundary with Douglas County

Eastern Boundary: Clayton County boundary with Henry County

Southern Boundary: Fulton County boundary with Coweta County and Fayette County boundaries.

Zone G: Portions of northern DeKalb County (Dunwoody, North Atlanta, Chamblee, Doraville) (Includes N.A.B.A. Club and The Biscayne Room)

Northern Boundary: DeKalb County boundary with northern Fulton County (Sandy Springs)

Western Boundary: DeKalb County boundary with central Fulton County (Sandy Springs/Atlanta)

Eastern Boundary: DeKalb County boundary with Gwinnett County

Southern Boundary: Interstate 85 (I-85) beginning at DeKalb County/Gwinnett County boundary and running southwest to the DeKalb County/Fulton County boundary.

Zone H: Portions of west-central DeKalb County (Druid Hills, Decatur, Avondale Estates) (Includes Clubscape Club)

Northern Boundary: DeKalb County/northern Fulton County boundary (Sandy Springs)

Western Boundary: DeKalb County/central Fulton County boundary (Sandy Springs/Atlanta)

Eastern Boundary: Interstate 285 (I-285) from Interstate 85 (I-85) running south to Interstate 20 (I-20).

Southern Boundary: Interstate 285 (I-285) from Interstate 20 (I-20) running southwest to the DeKalb County/Fulton County boundary.

Zone I: Portions of north and east Cobb County (East Cobb)

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Northern Boundary:	Cobb County/Cherokee County boundary (from Bells Ferry Road in west to Fulton County boundary in east)
Western Boundary:	Bells Ferry Road from Cherokee County boundary running south to its intersection with Cobb Parkway (GA Hwy 3/ U.S. Hwy 41), then running southeast along GA Hwy 3 to the Cobb County/Fulton County boundary (Chattahoochee River).
Eastern Boundary:	Cobb County/Fulton County boundary (Chattahoochee River)
Southern Boundary:	GA Hwy 3 in Cobb County and Cobb County/Fulton County boundary (Chattahoochee River)..

Zone J: Portions of southern and southwest Cobb County (Austell, Smyrna, and downtown and southern portions of Marietta) (Includes Freedom Club)

Northern Boundary:	Cobb Parkway (GA Hwy 3/U.S. Hwy 41) beginning at Canton Road running south along a line which is parallels to but west of (not including) Church Street, through Marietta GA continuing south until the intersection of South Marietta Parkway (GA Hwy 120) and Powder Springs Road (GA Hwy 360), then southwest along Powder Springs Road to Flint Hill Road south of Powder Springs, then along Brownsville Road to the Cobb County/Paulding County boundary.
Western Boundary:	Cobb County/Paulding County boundary from Douglas County to Brownsville Road.
Eastern Boundary:	Cobb Parkway (GA Hwy 3/U.S. Hwy 41) beginning at Canton Road running southeast along Cobb Parkway to Interstate 285 (I-285), then running south and southwest along the Cobb County/Fulton County boundary (Chattahoochee River) to the Cobb County/Douglas County boundary.
Southern Boundary:	Cobb County/Douglas County boundary.

Zone K: Portions of north and west Cobb County (Acworth, Kennesaw, Powder Springs, and western portions of Marietta) (Includes REBOS Club)

Northern Boundary:	Cobb County/Cherokee County boundary (from Cobb County/Paulding County boundary in west to Bells Ferry Road in east).
Western Boundary:	Cobb County/Paulding County boundary from Cherokee County in the north to Brownsville Road in the south.
Eastern Boundary:	Bells Ferry Road from Cherokee County boundary running south to its intersection with Cobb Parkway (GA Hwy 3/U.S. Hwy 41), then running southeast along Cobb Parkway to its intersection with GA Hwy 5 (Church Street), then south along a line which is parallel to but west of (not including) Church St. through Marietta GA continuing south until the intersection of South Marietta Parkway (GA Hwy 120) and Powder Springs Road (GA Hwy 360), then southwest along Powder Springs Road to Flint Hill Road south of Powder Springs.
Southern Boundary:	Powder Springs Road from Flint Hill Road southwest along Brownsville Road to the Cobb County/Paulding County boundary.

Zone L: Portions of Fulton County lying north of the Chattahoochee River (Roswell, Alpharetta, Johns Creek, and Milton).
